

#### 2015 Analogue Radio Switch Off

Now that we have all switched over to **Digital TV**, the next big thing is the switch off of **Analogue Radio** in **2015**. Whilst this might seem a little while away, we have been made aware that this may be bad news for **Galmpton**.

The switch off means traditional radio receivers will have to be replaced by the new *Digital Audio Broadcast* (DAB) radios. However, a resident has emailed us to say he is concerned that parts of **Galmpton** may not be able to receive a **DAB** signal. He pointed out that he had a <u>portable</u> **DAB** radio for Christmas and cannot pick up a strong enough signal to receive <u>any</u> **DAB** stations, even though he can receive regular analogue radio signals.

**Galmpton** is in a valley location that may prevent the different type of **DAB** signal getting to all parts of the village. We can make representations to the **Broadcasting** authorities to ask for an improved reception if this is seen as a common problem. If you have similar problems receiving **DAB** radio signals, please E-mail us now via **secretary@galmptontorbay.org.uk**.

### Traffic Problems ~ The Roundings & Greenway Road

We have been informed that parking during **Galmpton Primary School** opening and closing times is becoming a big problem for some residents in **Greenway Road** and **The Roundings**. We understand the area has been gridlocked on some days and appears to be getting worse each year.

We have received requests from residents for views on implementing parking restrictions to improve road safety for pedestrians, residents, and motorists in the area. One proposal is for double yellow lines on both sides of **Greenway Road** between Stoke Gabriel Road and The Roundings and on one side of **The Roundings** itself.

Could we ask for residents views on problems experienced in the area and whether they think this suggestion is worth progressing before we take it to committee? If there is an appetite for it, we could raise it with the **Council Highways Department**.

### **Speed Limits**

You will no doubt have seen that the **30-mph Dartmouth Road** speed limit extension has now been implemented. We will continue our campaign for a **20-mph** limit in **Galmpton** village centre during **2010**.

## Galmpton Residents' Association News Planning Application ~ Higher Warborough Road

We were made aware of a revised planning application in **December 2009**, to demolish a house in **Higher Warborough Road**, replacing it with three dormer bungalows. Many nearby residents have protested that this creates a traffic hazard, is over-development and creates a dangerous precedent. The **GRA** has previously agreed that siting 3 dwellings on the site is over-development and has written to the **Council** to register this.

### **Protecting the Common from Travellers**

We are concerned that a **Torbay Council** consultation regarding how best to protect the **Common** from **Traveller** invasion did not happen in **Autumn 2009** as promised at a **Community Partnership** meeting.

We previously identified from our own survey over 18-months ago, that the most popular solution was a grassed-up earth bank. The **Mayor** appeared to state in the **Herald Express**, that although this was a good idea, it was not affordable. We have subsequently been told that his comments had been misinterpreted and the proposal has not yet been properly defined.

We are currently following this up with the **Council** as we have heard no more about it and we want a resolution before the annual invasion of **Travellers** on the **Common**. Our concern is that the **Traveller** numbers visiting are increasing each year and the local authorities have legal difficulties in moving them on quickly once they have taken up residence.

### The Future of the Association

For some time the **GRA** has been operating without a **Chairman** elected by the **AGM**. It could be argued that this is unconstitutional and it is important that the **GRA** comes to a common mind as to the action to be taken.

Ideally we would like to elect a **Chairman**. All we need is a <u>volunteer</u>. Contact the secretary to find out what is involved.

It might be possible to amend the **Constitution** to permit the present situation to continue, though this puts an additional load on the **Secretary**. Finally there is the nuclear option. The **Association** could be disbanded.

Let us hope we can avoid the worst. Almost two-thirds of households approached have supported the **GRA** with cash this year; thank you all very much. It does seem the work done is appreciated. Please don't let it all go to waste. Come to the **AGM** and take part in this important debate.

#### Report of Public Meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> December

The focus of our last meeting was the proposed development of a **Sailing Centre** at **Broadsands Beach**. Unsurprisingly the proposals elicited strong reactions – for and against! Two key themes in the concerns raised were the management of the interaction between swimmers and sailors, and the risk of changing the beach so much that its traditional use as a family "*bucket and spade*" location would be lost. Arguments in favour of the development included the huge benefits from having a world class dinghy sailing facility here in Torbay, and the general improvements that would be made to the whole Beach environment as a result of the development.

This proposal is not just about building a sailing school, but would also include redevelopment of the existing cafe, redesigning the car park in a way that would help eliminate the joy riders and enhancing the landscaping. A show of hands at the end of the presentation revealed a small majority in favour.

Personally, I believe the proposals have great merit provided they take proper account of the concerns raised. More importantly however, I am committed to ensuring that full and proper consultation takes place with the local community. The December presentation was just the start of this consultation, not the end!

On the subject of consultation, you will be receiving a questionnaire in the next few weeks asking for your views on what the Community Partnership should be doing. Please take the time to respond, so that we can truly represent the local community.




