No Cold Calling Homes Initiative

This Torbay **Trading Standards** scheme was announced in **THE GAZETTE Issue 28 Winter 2012** on **Page 20**. If a trader visits a house that is clearly a **No Cold Calling Home**, then **Trading Standards** can take action to help ensure they do not return. Approved Traders Register

You may be aware that all Government forms will soon only exist online!!! People without a computer will be able to go to the Post Office and get a list of approved locations offering computer access and assistance.

Several local organisations, with support from Gary Deare at Galmpton PO, are proposing a similar scheme for approved traders such as electricians, gas tradesmen, roofers, builders, etc. If anyone needed work to be carried out they would obtain a short-list of local traders from the local Post Office.

If this idea appeals to you, then please let Gary Deare, a local Councillor, a local police officer, or a Community Partnership representative know that you are keen to support such a scheme.

'For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus' (1Timothy ch2 v5 NKJV).

As a local Church here in Galmpton we are a group of Christian believers worshipping at Flavel Chapel also known as Galmpton Congregational Evangelical Church.

You might wonder what makes us different from other Churches or even what is a Congregational Church? During the 16th Century it became very obvious that the medieval Church had drastically departed from the simple but profound teaching of Christ supplanting it by human tradition. As people returned to the authority of God's Word as found in the Scriptures some believers became known as 'Independents' or 'Congregationalists'. They held that as there is no Mediator between God and man except Christ this truth applied not only to the individual but should also apply to the local Church or Congregation. This means that Christ alone is the one true Head of the Church Who should be looked to that He might directly guide each local church and its officers as they submit to the authority of Scripture under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. This does not mean that we are isolationists but we would consider it unnecessary or even dangerous to have a Church hierarchy imposing decisions on the local Church. However we hold in high regard the great confessions of faith that outline mainstream historical Christianity and consider them to be of great importance since we believe the Holy Spirit has been teaching the faithful down through the ages. We are therefore not a sect and if you came to any of the Church Services, which you are warmly invited to do, you will not be presented with novel interpretations of Scripture but the same unchanging but ever fresh teaching that our forefathers loved centring on 'For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life' (John 3 v16 NKJV).

News Update

- At the time of Refusal of their last Application in March, Bloor Homes announced that they would Appeal the Council's Decision to the Government. At the time of writing (5th July) no such Application has been made, and the time to do so will expire by mid - September.
- On the 26th April a further Planning Application was made. This being only for new holes in the AONB in order to extend the golf course and replace the land given over for housing development. No Application for a replacement Clubhouse has been made.
- This further Application was scheduled to come before the Planning Committee on Monday 8th July, but has been postponed, most likely to September according to Torbay Planning Dept.
- Torbay Planning Officers have stated that the reason for postponement is that the circumstances and the nature of the Application are unchanged from those Refused in March, particularly as concerns wildlife habitat protection for endangered species. This being so, the Council would have no option but to refuse this Application too.
- RAGS & the Community Partnership are convinced that the case for Refusal of this Development proposal is robust, and we are prepared and committed to continue to oppose the development within the AONB, Coastal Preservation Area, and Special Area of Conservation, whether this be by way of Appeal or new Application.
- To this end we shall continue to strengthen our case and provide Expert evidence to underpin our arguments.

Community Partnership Churston, Galmpton & Broadsands

Thank you to those residents who attended our AGM and showed support for the work of the Steering Group by re-electing the same people for this coming year.

Brokenbury Sports Hub – Torbay Council strategic planning officers (those in the Council responsible for delivering Neighbourhood Plans in line with HM Govt Localism agenda) have proposed in the latest draft of the Local Plan to allocate Brokenbury for a major sports hub. This is the same idea that as a community we previously strongly opposed in our Community Partnership survey or minireferendum. However, the idea received cross-party support from Brixham, Paignton and Torquay Councillors, and now features in the draft Local Plan.

Golf Course — See the update from RAGS. Although Golf Course members were informed by the Board of the Club there was to be a planning hearing in July to consider proposals to relocate 3 new golf holes onto the AONB, this has not and will not happen. It had been proposed that as environmental mitigation the Club would run a "sacrificial herd" of cattle to be infected with Bovine TB. Farmer Richard Haddock, whose Farm Shop relies on selling high quality local produce, has understandably made it clear he could not agree to be associated with such farming practices, hence the application has stalled.

The Common — Works have taken place to reinforce previous weak entry spots with over 150 tons of large boulders. However, Travellers recently accessed the Common across some of the existing "sharks teeth". It is now helpfully recognised these are not large enough to keep vehicles out. Work to reinforce the Langdon Lane side with a likely further 50 tons of Boulders will happen as soon as the local residents with the heavy plant equipment (diggers, etc.) have the time.

Park and Ride – As was reported in the press, the Torbay Council run Park-and-Ride had closed, thus making for an interesting traffic picture along the Dartmouth Road in the summer. It has since been re-opened by 2 well known local residents who were supported by Councillor Derek Mills.

Neighbourhood Planning – It remains that Neighbourhood Planning is the only way we can get the things we want for our area and avoid the things we do not want. There are only a handful of local residents undertaking most of the work. We could do with extra help and support, and would appreciate any assistance.
