For whom the bell tolls

‘Therefore never send to know for whom the bell tolls.
It tolls for thee.’

With these words John Donne concluded his poem ‘No man is an island.’ I’ve often thought of that poem as I hear the Flavel Chapel bell ringing on a Sunday morning. For whom is the bell tolling? It’s tolling for you.

The good news of Jesus Christ is spoken of, and explained, every Sunday at the chapel. Jesus Christ taught us that God is interested in all that goes on in our lives. But because we tend to ignore Him, we don’t know what He is truly like, nor what He expects of us.

So God sent his Son, some 2,000 years ago, with a particular mission and a particular message. The mission was to make God known and ultimately for Jesus to give his life so that our sins might be paid for him rather than by us on judgement day. The message was that if we repent of our sins and be baptised, God will give us his Holy Spirit, in order that we might become the people He intended us to be.

This is good news because it means that those sins of ours which irritate us (and others!) can be overcome. But not only do we become aware of our sins, we learn how they can be forgiven and how we can be reconciled to God.

All of which is part of the good news of God’s kingdom. The kingdom in which Jesus Christ is king, and of which Christians are ambassadors.

From BRIXHAM RECTORY

Did you know that according to the TV programme QI people all over the world are now walking 10% faster than they did a decade ago?

I am not really surprised as the rate I am doing things over the past few months seems to have grown quite considerably BUT I do not think it is just because I am looking after more churches. A lot of it is because our churches are busier than ever, for example more people came to Christmas services in Churston and Galmpton in 2013 than in previous years.

With Easter being so late this year, Ash Wednesday is on the 5th of March; a month that begins with a Shared Lunch of soup, dessert & coffee at the Barn Hall on the 1st (£5 tickets to be bought in advance please.) During Lent there will be our usual Ecumenical study groups. On the 16th there will be the Annual General Church Meeting, at the Parish Church after the 9:30 am service.

April too is full of events. Palm Sunday morning (13th April) will include our Confirmation with Bishop Nick of Crediton presiding, and our regular Palm Sunday concert in the Barn Chapel will take place in the afternoon that day. Watch out for posters with further details nearer the time. Easter day will begin with what is now our traditional dawn service at the Parish Church, followed by 8:00 am Eucharist at the Barn Chapel, and a 9:30 am Eucharist at the Parish Church.

The next day (Monday) Churston Parish Church will be open so you can see our wonderful Easter flowers close up and there will be coffee, cakes and other goodies on sale in the refectory from 10:30 am to about lunchtime.

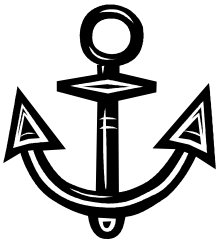

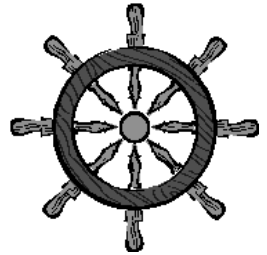

Residents Against Golf Club Sell-off R.A.G.S.

News Update

- Bloor Homes and Churston Golf Club have appealed to the Government regarding their Planning Application for a new clubhouse and new golf holes after it was refused by Torbay Council in March 2013.
- The Appeal will be heard by an Inspector at a **Public Inquiry** scheduled to take up to 2 weeks and commencing **10:00 am 25th March 2014** in the Riviera International Conference Centre, Chestnut Avenue, Torquay.
- Public participation is an important part of the Inquiry and attendance by RAGS supporters will be greatly appreciated.
- Following the Inquiry, the Inspector's decision is expected to be made public 2 months later.
- The Planning Appeal will be defended by Torbay Council, together with RAGS and the Community Partnership as a joint 'Rule 6 Party'.
- Rule 6 Parties are a form of co-defendant who can present their own case, their own evidence and their own Expert Witnesses; separate from the Planning Authority (Torbay Council) but in support of the refusal decision.
- RAGS has engaged Legal Counsel to present our case and preparations are underway.
- Richard Haddock, local farmer, has been notified that Bloor Homes and the Golf Club wish to evict him from part of Churston Court Farm in order to make way for the development. Consequently, as the incumbent landowner, Richard is also a 'Rule 6 Party' co-defending the Council's decision to refuse the Planning Application.
- Richard Tooze, another local farmer, will also lose land currently used for equine use. Hence in total, through this development, two farmers are affected.
- RAGS continue to believe that the case for Refusal of this development is strong and we expect to prevail at the Public Inquiry. However, we recognise recent changes to Planning Regulations and Government statements that they intend to allow 'free reign for developers'.
- We feel that the outcome of this decision will materially determine how vulnerable the Churston, Breadsands and Galmpton areas are now and in the future and that we must hence - fight our corner to the bitter end.

R.A.G.S. needs financial contributions to support the campaign.

Community Partnership

Churston, Galmpton & Broadsands

Rather than the usual update of the work of the CP, we wanted to use this opportunity to explain the Bay-wide significance of certain decisions soon to be made regarding our area. By this we mean the Churston Golf Club inquiry.

Issues raised by the community to a large extent remain unanswered by the developer. For example, in relation to the poor pedestrian accessibility of the proposed site, the current proposal is to paint white lines on the road to create “virtual pavements” and we think the questionability of this idea is self evident.

Instead, Churston Golf Club and Bloor Homes will be asserting the emerging Local and Neighbourhood Plans are unsound, because Torbay is under calculating the numbers of houses that should be built. They submit that many more houses should be built than our Council currently says we need. They say that their development is the solution to this problem – so much so that it justifies the other harms resulting from their development.

The Council say 8,000 – 10,000 new homes need building over the next 20 years. *(This matches central government figures of needing 4,400 over the next 10 years)* We believe the Club and Developer will say we need as many as 16,340 homes *(based on a housing market assessment suggesting 817 per annum)*, which is almost double the amount currently in the Council plans.

Why is this relevant? Because, if the Golf Club and Bloor Homes succeed, then Torbay Council will have to re-write substantial sections of its Local Plan, and the community will have to re-write substantial sections of our Neighbourhood Plans.

Torbay as a whole would need to undertake the unenviable task of working out on which green field sites it will build another almost 8,000 new homes. For reference, the town of Brixham as a whole is about 10,000 homes. So building this many new homes would require a very substantial change to our geography.

The Golf Club Appeal will be heard by an Inspector at a Public Inquiry commencing on **25th March at 10:00 am** in the **Riviera International Conference Centre**. One way or another, the outcome will have implications for the whole of Torbay.
