

Teach us to number our days, that we may get a heart of wisdom.

These words from Psalm 90 were part of a prayer written some 3,500 years ago. It is still a good prayer for us today, because we all do well to number our days, to recognise that no matter how long we may live, our time here is finite, and that our work, if it is to last, must be established by God.

Contrary to popular belief, the Bible teaches that we are not inherently immortal, but that God offers all people eternal life through his son, Jesus Christ. This offer can be rejected or accepted, according to the choice of each person, but as long as it is day (i.e. while we are still living) the opportunity remains for all people to acknowledge Jesus as their Lord and Saviour, to turn from sin to follow him - and so receive eternal life.

Unfortunately however, most of the time we don't number our days, instead we squander them. My prayer for Galmpton residents this year is that we would all learn to number our days, that we might gain a heart of wisdom. And I am confident that the wise will take the opportunity to be reconciled to God through Jesus Christ - as opposed to remaining distant from Him by their sins - while it is yet day.

When Jesus saw their faith, he said ... "Son, your sins are forgiven."

Now some of the scribes were sitting there, questioning in their hearts ...

"Who can forgive sins but God alone?" (Mark 2:6-7)

As I write, we are in the week following the events that took place at the offices of 'Charlie Hebdo' in Paris. What are we to make of it all? Has the world gone mad?

It is very easy to point the finger at the Islamic jihadists and voice our condemnation at such atrocities, and so we should, though I am persuaded that to do just that does not fully address the issue. There has been a lot said about freedom of speech that is right and proper, but freedom to do something does not mean it is necessarily right.

'Charlie Hebdo' is run by satirists whose philosophy is that the human word, thinking and musings, and human nature in general are the highest things that exist in the world. It is the sort of machine that regards itself as having the right to take pops at anything without fear of the consequences. That is OK in one sense, and sometimes the bombastic & pompous, inefficient & down-right negligent in any organisation needs a pop at it, if only to reflect the silliness or negligence in a mirror. But does this give the right to offend? Yes it gives the opportunity, but is that right the right thing to do?

Al Qaeda and Isis are also machines. Their desire is to impose Islamic rule on everybody whether they want it or not, including Muslims, though by no means everyone who is a Muslim wants it. It too, is the sort of machine that regards itself as having the right to take pops at anything without fear of the consequences because it thinks that Allah is on their side. Unfortunately so sure are they of this that rather than persuade people (including many Muslims remember) that their brand of Islam is something that will work for the common good, they would rather impose it by force and by terror. They have the means to do this, but is it the right thing to do?

The truth is that both of these organisations are driven by human desire, one which disregards God altogether, the other which has a very mistaken view of what they think God desires. Both are too proud to back down, because they have insufficient love one for the other. Did 'Charlie Hebdo' have to be so offensive to Muslims? No. Did the men who committed these atrocities have to do so? No. Both did because their lack of love and respect, one for the other drew out the barb of the worst of their human nature.

The God I follow as a Christian tells me I should love my God, my neighbour as myself and that I should love my enemies as well. Not an easy task always, but that is what is demanded of me. If I fail in this, I am humble enough to ask for forgiveness. Showing true love is getting off the high horse we happen to be on and reconciling our differences. It is called love.

Torbay Local Plan

The Government Planning Inspector considering the **Torbay Local Plan** has announced that Torbay needs to build 10,000 homes over the next 20 years.

This number of households equates approximately to the entire Brixham Peninsula Neighbourhood Plan – clearly a large amount of housing – but was considered appropriate in light of the Council's "ambitious" jobs target.

What this means for our area will be down to the success of our Neighbourhood Plan; the Golf Course inquiry decision; and the Churston Covenant.

Neighbourhood Plan

The **Neighbourhood Plan** currently proposes to spread development out across the area with several smaller sites being developed for housing. This has been the strong community request since the initial public consultation events back in November 2012. This is different from the strategy of the Council which prefers individual larger sites such as those currently being developed near Whiterock.

Golf Course Inquiry

The **Golf Course inquiry** result is due by 17 February and is eagerly awaited given the clear consequences it will have for Bloor Homes' continued development interests in our area. Whilst the Community Partnership did receive a letter from the Directors of the Golf Course querying whether we would be interested in a meeting, when we replied positively the Directors pulled out. If the Directors decide they would like to meet with the community the door is always open.

Churston Covenant

The decision of Mayor Gordon Oliver to put in place what has been termed the **Churston Covenant** was a clear demonstration of the government policy of Localism at work. It currently remains unclear whether a small group of Councillors and other Mayoral candidates will be able to petition the Secretary of State to reverse the Mayors decision.


