Letter to the Editor

From a concerned local resident Dogs off the lead

Dear sir,

I'm writing to you in the hope you will be able to get my story out and remind dog owners how dangerous their dogs can be when off the lead.

On Sat 27th Dec, I was getting my horse Clyde in as normal about 3:30 pm. I stable him at Elberry Farm, Broadsands. As I went to shut the gate I caught a collie dog in the corner of my eye running towards us. I didn't worry too much as Clyde is good with dogs. The dog ran between his back legs and tried to bite them and his tail. Clyde swivelled around quickly to see what the problem was, causing me to fall. He then kicked out at the dog but unfortunately caught me full in the face & shoulder.

Now most people would check that I was okay. However, the dog walkers gave me a tissue and left me to be helped by some other horse owners. Luckily one of them was first aid trained, and she called for an ambulance, and assisted me. I don't remember a lot about the incident!

Later that evening I had X-rays & a scan. They described the right side of my face like a bowl of cornflakes. I had part of my jaw detached & floating, along with my nose smashed, and factures to both eye sockets. On the Monday I had over 5 hrs of surgery to put my face back together, and still need further surgery in the future. I can't thank Torbay hospital enough, and that includes all the staff from A & E, the Forest Ward, and surgical team led by Miss Fryer who have done an amazing job!

To this date the owners of the dog have not enquired or bothered to contact the yard as to my well being. I wonder if they would have been so reluctant if it had been their dog which had sustained injuries or even worse been killed?

This could have all been avoided if the dog had been under control, or better still on a lead.

Please get this story out to make people aware of what could happen if their dogs are not good around horses. I now have metal plates in my face for the rest of my life, all because this dog owner couldn't take a few seconds to put it on the lead.

Annual General Meeting ~ Monday 16th March

The Chairman thanked the Committee most sincerely for their total loyal support and stated that without their participation there would be no village hall for the community. All the existing trustees were re-elected.

During the past year the committee have at last seen the status of the Institute become an Incorporated Charity, its formal title being the Galmpton Village Institute. 'God, the government and the citizen'

In interesting political times what does Almighty God expect from the government and the citizen? The Bible teaches that we all have certain rights given to us by the God. These rights should not be taken from us, and if they are, the individual or government taking them away will be sinning. Two rights granted to us by God are:

- a) The right to life. Life is a gift from God and only He has the right to take your life from you, nobody else has that right. This is clear from the commandment 'You shall not murder', which could be rephrased as 'you have the right to live, and nobody has the right to take your life.'

Amongst Christians you will find people who respect your right to live (that's why Christians oppose abortion and euthanasia), and your right to property (that's why you can leave property unattended among Christians and it won't be stolen).

Do you want a government that respects your God-given rights? Then why not enter the kingdom of Jesus Christ – his embassies are open every Sunday - his ambassadors are everywhere. Credibility is a very important thing. We have just celebrated Easter and soon the General Election (!) is to be upon us; believing something in a world of uncertainty is very important.

With politicians believing their promises to the electorate is not an exact science! Something similar is happens in science too, where ideas and theories are put over as fact, when they are not always quite as they seem. I am very wary of any report that makes a claim to have discovered something by headline and then uses the words 'may', 'can' or 'could' to qualify it. That is not to say the idea is wrong, but it is not perhaps as 'cast iron' truth as we are led to believe. Some theologians do the same by trying to make the Bible fit their pet theory, rather than upholding the Bible as God's word of truth because it is inconvenient for them.

'Credible' is the important word here, from the Latin root 'cred' to believe. Not everything can be proven in terms of hard facts. Sometimes your instinct tells you something is right. Alexandre Gauthier for example cooks without weights, measures or clocks. His instinct tells him how much to use and when things are ready. He uses no recipe. He cooks by faith.

The disciples who witnessed Jesus walking among us, told us about how much God loves us in the New Testament and how Jesus' death and resurrection brings forgiveness and eternal life to believers. Their witness is credible to many today because instinct tells us it is believable through faith rather than hard fact. Many in the early church died as martyrs rather than deny their Lord. No fancy made-to-fit theory for them, but a transformation of heart through the love of Jesus.

GRA Annual General Meeting

Thank you to all the Residents who attended our annual AGM, which, after an address by guest speakers, involved a résumé of the GRA's community-related activities and expenditure over the past year. Further suggestions were made for flood-related precautions in the village.

Our existing committee was re-elected as above, with other members:-Richard Boyles (Webmaster), Helen Boyles (Community Partnership Rep), Steve Sherren (Subscriptions & Community Partnership Rep), Alan Knight, Sheila O'Connor, Andy Loader, and Piet Dijkshoorn.

Guest speakers, Adam Billings and Derek Mills, addressed the meeting on the contentious modifications to the Torbay Local Plan, which involve the re-designation of green fields adjoining Galmpton as a Future Growth area. By March 23rd, Torbay Council had received 100 letters objecting to the White Rock extension plan. A formal objection has been made to the proposal by Paignton Neighbourhood Forum, with the endorsement of Churston, Broadsands & Galmpton, and Brixham Neighbourhood Forums. Our speakers stressed the urgency of residents getting actively involved on issues significantly impacting the village.

Brixham Peninsula Neighbourhood Plan (BPNP)

The draft Galmpton/Churston/Broadsands/Brixham reports have now been formally edited and amalgamated to produce the final draft BPNP. Sustainability analysis reports must be produced before going forward to a 6 week Public Consultation with final opportunities for GRA representatives to suggest necessary improvements or adjustments to the factual content of the draft. The Referendum for final approval will be held later in 2015.

Friends of Galmpton Common

Responses to the recent public consultation have been collated. Residents are generally in favour of some protective boundary to the common, with greater preference for a earth and grass bund than the existing, unsightly large boulders. All are anxious to preserve this precious amenity.

Windy Corner Junction

Plans to address the traffic flow on the Ring Road from White Rock to Windy Corner, including possible options to improve the actual junction are planned for 2016.

Residents Against Golf Club Sell-off R.A.G.S.

RAGS was formed 5 years ago in order to fight Plans to develop housing on Churston Golf Course and expand the course to build a new Clubhouse.

We are delighted to report that we have been triumphant, in that all of our objectives have been fully achieved.

On 3rd February 2015, Dr. Paul Dignan, Government Inspector, concluded, after a marathon Inquiry which took 4 sittings weeks, spanning a period of 10 months, ruled that development could not take place. The reasons given for his decision were Traffic Congestion, Loss of Visual Amenity and Environmental Impact on Protected Species. RAGS has always been confident that our case would prevail.

In addition to the Planning judgement the developer Bloor Homes has been informed by Torbay Council that the Conditional Contract made in 2011 by former Mayor Nick Bye has expired and has been rescinded by Mayor Gordon Oliver. Consequently, Bloor Homes has no rights to access the land required for development and the original Covenant preventing change of use for development remains in place.

A further Covenant has been granted by Mayor Gordon Oliver and is currently awaiting approval from Eric Pickles, Secretary of State. If successful this will ensure that no further attempts at development could succeed without the agreement of local Residents.

Given Mayor Gordon Oliver's support for preserving Green Spaces and Localism, we hope that he will be re-elected on 7th May.

For RAGS this is our 'swan song'. We have fulfilled our objectives in full and wish to express our sincere thanks to all those many residents of Churston, Galmpton & Broadsands who enthusiastically gave their unstinting support throughout the last 5 years.

Churston Golf Course Inquiry

The Government Planning Inspector examining the proposal by Bloor Homes and the Golf Club to relocate the Clubhouse to the 3rd tee refused the development on the following grounds:

- Highway Safety impact on pedestrian safety and traffic queues;
- Environment impact on protected Greater Horseshoe Bat habitat; and
- Landscape impact on the 'open countryside' character of the area.

This is a very clear decision which is welcomed by Community Partnership and this is particularly the case when the reasons which were relied on by the Inspector in reaching his decision would apply to practically every other alternative scheme to relocate the clubhouse. This means that whilst there is a current planning consent to build 132 houses on the site of the existing clubhouse that consent cannot currently be implemented.

Churston Golf Course Covenant

Given the Inspector's decision means it is less likely the Golf Course will be developed, it is disappointing that efforts by a small group of Councillors to undermine the Mayor's decision to place a covenant on the Golf Course in favour of the local community have resulted in the Secretary of State requesting further information. This means it is possible that implementation of the decision is delayed until after the election. Whilst Mayor Gordon Oliver has always maintained the local community should have a say in any development of the golf course this has historically not always been the position of all other candidates.

Galmpton – White Rock 2 Development

The Council has plans to build a further 450 houses on the green fields between the new development near South Devon College, and the car boot field adjacent Galmpton village. Through the work of the CP, the Brixham Peninsula Neighbourhood Forum has formally objected to this proposal and set out how it undermines the Neighbourhood Plan. We await the Council's response.


