Two years ago James & Cathy Pidgeon took over **The Weary Ploughman**. They soon introduced handmade take away Pizza, and are now offering by popular demand their own take away Fish & Chips.

Over recent years, **The Manor Inn** has gone through several phases of regeneration. The latest incumbents Chris & Jonathan, just last year have regenerated **Churston Manor**, and starred on television with Alex Polizzi in **The Hotel Inspector**.

Jonathan is not only involved with those businesses, but also is treasurer of **Galmpton Festival Association** and **Galmpton Residents' Association**. Both of those organisations have undergone regeneration recently. The former was previously Galmpton Floral Days, and has added new life to both the **Open Gardens** and the **Autumn Festival**. The latter came close to winding up without new blood last year, but now has a new committee chaired by Jeremy Partridge.

Jeremy has also been busy running events to raise funds for **Rowcroft**. Those include Christmas **Steam & Carols**, the **Greenway Singing Night**, Galmpton **Bonfire & Fireworks Display**, and the **Music & Magic** train trip on the forthcoming Valentine's night.

Another new venture is the **Galmpton Community Cinema** film society that should be starting soon in the **Village Institute** to provide a local alternative for enjoying the movies. It is purely coincidental that **Greenway National Trust** had a popup cinema for the first time this Christmas.

Also, there is the Torbay Community Development Trust & Ageing Well, the Community Partnership, Friends of Galmpton Common, Friends of Churston Library, and many others, all playing their part in regeneration.

Only Scripture

The Reformation of the Church that began in the 16th Century aimed to replace Church tradition with the bedrock of Scripture. This was to recover the original authentic message of the Christian Faith. Over the centuries tradition within the Church had grown in extent, prevalence and importance so as to obscure and supplant the original teachings of Christ and the Apostles. The Church services were in Latin and the only available Bible was the Latin Vulgate translation. This meant people did not have easy access to the truth and were dependent on an influential Church officer called a priest to teach them and administer, according to Church tradition, the blessings they might receive from God.

The Reformation progressively swept all of this tradition aside and replaced it with the authoritative Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments that were translated into the language of the hearers. This included William Tyndale's monumental English translation through which he intended to make the ploughboy more knowledgeable in the Scriptures than the priest! Consequently, one of the five distinctive 'Solas of the Reformation' was 'Sola Scriptura', which translates as 'Only Scripture'. This means that Scripture alone and certainly not tradition is the only authoritative standard to determine what is acceptable within the Church in regard to teaching and practice. This is most important today when many in society expect the Church to conform to the world, so that when the world changes its view they expect the Church to follow.

Jesus said to His followers, 'You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet'. (Matthew 5 v13 (ESV). People do not go to Church to hear political correctness but to hear the truth of God. The Church that panders to please the world forfeits the favour and blessing of God.

Seeing in Lent

Easter is earlyish this year on April 1st, so preparing for it is early too. February 14th is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the church period of Lent. During Lent we reflect on our lives, our life with God, what we have done well and not so well, and on our spiritual health as opposed to our physical or mental needs, though there is a relationship between all three.

It is a good thing to do; we can gauge if our physical health is good or not, and generally the same with our mental health; we know when we are stressed or not, at breaking point or OK. Spiritual health is the one we often neglect. We might think such a thing doesn't exist, we don't need it or in the great scheme of things it is not important. We may think that we are 'not good enough' to be spiritually healthy; we may wish we had some spirituality but don't know where to start. Are we right?

That is why Lent is good; we can clean out some of our inner clutter so that we can see more clearly. As I have got older, I have found this process more valuable each year. What is more important in life? Making money? What we have and guard jealously? Family? How we live and love in our life? Could we give something back? What about forgiveness? Being forgiven? Is there a God? How do I connect with him if he is there?

Whether a believer or not, taking time out to reassess priorities is important if we are not to lose ourselves and become overwhelmed by what goes on around us. In a world only too happy to promote physical health, a bit less worried about mental health and with little time for things spiritual, time to reflect is vital to see what matters.

Long-Term Plan

As mentioned in the previous update, we are now working on the **Long-Term Plan** as required and agreed with the council. We have received a lot of informal feedback, and a limited number of formal responses to the questions we posed in the last *GAZETTE*, about the aspects of perimeter protection people are happy with, and about the community's priorities for our work, including initial ideas about improving the Langdon Lane (Brixham side) perimeter. It is interesting that the issue that comes up time and time again is the lack of a path down Langdon lane, and it would seem appropriate to consider building this into long term perimeter protection.

However, before moving on to this detailed work, we do need more robust initial consultation and are planning to have a leaflet drop around the village with a very brief survey. Copies will also be available at **Galleon Stores**. We aim to complete this by the end of February, before working up more detailed options for Langdon Lane (or an alternative focus, if that should be the community consensus). Our plan is to organise public consultation events to get feedback on these options during the Spring.

Maintenance of Common

Also as a preliminary to the plan, (and as we have been delegated authority to take on maintenance of copses, ditches, etc, by the council) we accepted a helpful offer from Devon Wildlife Trust for one of their officers to do a site visit and make recommendations about managing the natural calciferous grassland environment. This took place in November and we received a very useful report about maintaining and enhancing the habitat both in terms of flora and fauna. We were mindful of this when our Autumn work group tidied and cut back the small copse, and did other maintenance tasks. The report will be very useful when we get to the point of engaging all stakeholders about managing the ecology, later this year. The focus would be to of maximise the diversity of plants, birds, butterflies, bats, insects, and other animals.

As the Spring approaches, we will also need to organise work groups to trim and clear ditches and undertake any other essential maintenance before the growing season starts. We will also continue to review on an ongoing basis short term perimeter protection measures and strengthen these should it be necessary. Our aim is to ensure another year free from unauthorised encampments, so that the ecology can flourish, and people can continue to enjoy the common without interruption or interference.

Neighbourhood Plan

The GRA Committee would like to express grateful thanks to all who sent messages of support for the redesignation of the Neighbourhood Forum and for the renewal of the Neighbourhood Plans. This contributed hugely to the Council voting almost unanimously in support of the Forums and for the renewal of the Plans. So 'people-power' can work! The next important milestone to look out for is when the Plans are put to a Referendum vote – we will let you know when this is imminent.

Whiterock 11 Application

All this is important as the Neighbourhood Plans, once formally ratified, have the potential to be a powerful source of support for the protection of land South of Whiterock (fields along the Brixham Road up to the car boot field). 392 objections were sent in with about 7 in favour, so we thank residents for their strong and well-argued letters and emails of objection. The application will very likely have to go to a judicial review. We will of course keep everyone informed of next steps. If you missed the earlier chance of objecting, letters can still be submitted.

Village Traffic

The GRA are also grateful to the School staff, the Torbay Highways Officer, and PCSO, as well as a number of villagers who have given a considerable amount of time for discussions on improving traffic conditions within the village, as well as child safety at the School opening and closing times. Considerable progress has been achieved in devising a plan to be implemented as soon as possible. In addition, our Ward Councillors have informed us that funds could soon be available for implementing a 20-mph speed limit, at least within the vicinity of schools in the village.

Subscriptions

We have postponed collection of membership subscriptions (unaltered at £3.00 per household) from the Autumn until Spring 2018. Payment can be made to collectors or be paid in either at Galmpton Post Office or the Manor Inn, but all homes will be called on and/or leafleted nearer the time. Volunteer collectors even for a small number of houses would be very much welcomed.

As the CP congratulates our local **Cllr Derek Mills** in his new role as **Executive Lead on Planning** we highlight the key historical Planning issues he can help with:-

Neighbourhood Plans (NPs)

The latest set of consultation responses on the Submitted NPs are now available: www.torbay.gov.uk/council/policies/planning-policies/neighbourhood-plans

The majority of objections come from Council Officers; officers in Planning have made detailed negative comments on almost every policy, and officers in the TDA have objected to every single Local Green Space. These representations state they have been made on behalf of the Council (hence our Elected Councillors).

There are several problems in this: the Planning officer and the TDA officer representations conflict, so they cannot both be the views of the Council; the Planning officer representations across different Plans also appear to conflict; there is no evidence these representations were properly authorised under the Council's constitution or by Elected Councillors or submitted on time.

On a positive side the appointment of the Assessors is progressing, and tenders are sought from potential Assessors by 5th February. The timetable agreed by the Council and the Forums has a final report on the Plan being given to the Council by 11th May 2018, and works on the basis the Assessor will hold a hearing.

Funding

The £10,000 owed by Torbay Council to the Neighbourhood Forum in exchange for allocating sites in the NP as promised in public by Cllr David Thomas and Pat Steward remains outstanding. It is unclear why, as new issues keep being raised. The Brixham Town Clerk is doing an excellent job following up on this for our area.

White Rock II (Inglewood)

A key issue the Forums are taking up is Torbay's 5 year land supply, as Officers claim the Council does not have one, whilst the Forums disagree.

The resolution appears simple as the issue is largely one of fact. However, there has been a history of bad working relations. There is also the issue of whether the 5 year supply is even relevant given Habitat Regulation Assessment (HRA) issues.


