The 3rd of the five solae that are key teachings of the Protestant Reformation is "Sola gratia" which means by grace alone. This is a precious truth that needs to sink deep into our hearts. It means firstly, that none of us by nature deserve the blessing and favour of God since we are all guilty of rejecting His authority and we have defiantly broken His commandments and standards. Consequently, all that God really owes us is condemnation and judgement. However, secondly, the amazing truth is that God in His love and grace has provided a wonderful way of salvation through the life, death and resurrection of Christ. He suffered - the innocent in the place of the guilty so that God's justice might be met in the punishment of sin, and at the same time He can justly show mercy and pardon to those who repent of their sin and receive Christ as their Saviour. This salvation is due to the grace of God alone since none of us deserve it or can earn it for ourselves. It is the free gift of God. Paul the Apostle wrote explaining this free salvation to the Ephesians, "For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. (Eph 2 v8-10 ESV) Centuries later John Newton experienced this salvation and wrote this well-known Hymn in which he clearly attributes his personal salvation to the grace of God alone:

Amazing grace! How sweet the sound, 'Twas grace that taught my heart to fear, That saved a wretch like me! And grace my fears relieved; I once was lost, but now am found; How precious did that grace appear Was blind. but now I see. The hour I first believed!

Through many dangers, toils and snares I have already come; 'Tis grace has brought me safe thus far, And grace will lead me home.

Prior to the *unauthorised camping season* our volunteers have, as planned, strimmed and cleared the ditches and reviewed the perimeter protection. One area of ditch did need deepening. After the grass was cut a resident noticed a boulder had been moved and alerted us. (Thank you!) It looked as if someone had been preparing to gain access, so we have put a much bigger boulder there. Travellers were observed trying to get on the common the first weekend in June, but did not succeed. So far so good! Fingers crossed for the next seven weeks! It is noticeable that after a couple of years with no damage the ecology has recovered, particularly wildlife and fauna in the copse; and the bats are around much more!

The update on the long-term plan is that we have now had an encouraging meeting with the council, sharing with them our progress so far; the results of our initial survey; the ecology report from Devon Bat project; and the ideas we have about a bund and path down Langdon Lane. They were particularly positive about the survey work; the high response and overwhelming support it demonstrated. They were also supportive of initial actions taken to benefit the ecology by leaving an uncut area around the edge, to support plants and wildlife. Before giving us the formal OK to work up and develop our ideas for Langdon Lane, council officers have gone back to their legal department to ensure proposals are compliant with the bye-laws. Currently we are waiting for feedback. If the council give us the go ahead, we will firm up proposals and costs, prior to exhibiting them for comment in conjunction with our **AGM** at **7:00 pm Tues 25**th **September** in the **Churston Pavilion**, Galmpton.

There are obviously significant cost implications, even if some work is done by volunteers. Implementation will depend on fundraising both in the local community and by applying for grants. So, given the council's agreement, it is going to take some time before the project gets underway and current protection measures will need to stay in place until the work is done.

Neighbourhood Plans (NPs)

At the last public meeting the CP was asked why the neighbourhood plan was so long and why it was important. The plan seeks to deliver community objectives using input from the various expert professionals who have been involved in preparing it. The main purpose of the plan is to inform planning applications and it is likely the document will be poured over by more professionals if there is money at stake. On this basis the document is not the easiest read! It is however a key document which will inform the White Rock II (Inglewood) development.

By the time you read this it is likely the Neighbourhood Forum will have received a final version of the Examiners report on the 3 separate Neighbourhood Plans for Torquay, Paignton and Brixham.

The next step will be for the Council to consider the report and consider whether as a result of new evidence or fact or a different interpretation of a fact, it disagrees with the report.

If the Council fully agrees with the inspectors report it is possible a referendum may be held by the end of the year.

White Rock II (Inglewood) and Windy Corner Junction

There have been further delays in the Inglewood proposals. The latest information the CP has is the application may go to a planning committee in September at the earliest.


