## Harvest Thanksgiving

Harvest Thanksgiving seems to be a tradition as old as the church itself, but in fact, it is a relatively recent invention in the 1843 by the Reverend James Hawker of Morwenstow, in Cornwall. Although there must have been some kind of traditional folk gathering before then, it was he who thought of placing the giving of thanks to God for the food we eat at the place where people gave thanks to God for anything else – in the church.

In those days people were very much more in tune with the fortunes of nature to provide sun and rain for crops to grow and for livestock to remain healthy. They appreciated what the blessings or devastation of crop growth really meant – food on the table or not.

These days people are far more blasé about their food. Not only do folk go to big supermarkets out of convenience (I am just stating a fact here!), they expect to find what they want, when they want it. The rotation of seasonal food is almost a thing of the past.

Do we give thanks at table for the production and transport of the food and what we are eating? Do we give thanks to God for keeping us well-fed? How easy it is to forget; but we should not.

Those who work in industries that get food to our plate very often work very hard for long hours and little reward. Some do not even manage to make ends meet and organisations such as the Farm Crisis Network work hard to give food producers a helping hand when they really need it. This is the side of farming we never see.

So, next time you sit down to take a bite from your plate, I invite you to pause and ask yourself 'How did this food land on my plate, and to whom should I be thankful?' Churston Church will give thanks on September 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**New Chairman and Vice Chair** – At the **AGM** on 19<sup>th</sup> June last, Adam Billings ended his 8 year [!] term as Chairman. A stupendous stint, culminating in the success of the **Neighbourhood Plan** at the referendum on 2<sup>nd</sup> May. **Brian Payne** [Broadsands] was elected Chairman and **Derek Mills** [Churston] Vice Chairman.

**Neighbourhood Plan** – This enjoyed a **Yes** vote of 90% on a 40% turnout on 2<sup>nd</sup> May. It is now part of the Statutory Development Plan for Torbay and will thus be a key document requiring consideration in all planning applications. It represents the most significant expression of the community wishes incorporated in a formal document in recent decades.

**Working with Brixham Community Partnership** – After discussions with the Brixham CP Secretary, and a general discussion at the AGM, it was agreed that a trial period of working together to combine resources across the Neighbourhood Plan area should take place. Brixham CP members are currently being consulted on the proposal. This will allow close consultation with all five West Torbay councillors.

**White Rock “2”** – The adoption of the Neighbourhood Plan puts significant hurdles in front of any application to develop this area. However, a grant of delay in the application and an update of the *Local* Plan [Torbay Council’s] in 2020/21 mean that the application has not gone away, and close monitoring will continue to be necessary.

**Moving Forward** – The febrile atmosphere of national and local politics makes it more important than ever that communities engage with their political representatives with a strong voice and are clear about wishes and choices. So do support and attend the Community Partnership meetings to ensure this happens.
