# Editorial

Happy New Year to all our readers

I guess you've put your decorations away and made new year resolutions. Don't put sparkly Christmas cards in for recycling as they spoil the batch.

## RNLI ~ Perfect Storm

The RNLI is a charity that saves lives at sea by providing a rescue service, supervision on beaches and safety education. The crews and lifeguards have saved over 142,400 lives since the RNLI was formed in 1824.

Separate from the coastguard and independent of the government, the RNLI is totally reliant on donations and fundraising to run its 238 lifeboat stations covering 19,000 miles of coastline. It is also heavily reliant on volunteers who comprise 95% of RNLI staff. It cost a total of £215.8m to run the RNLI in 2017 (£176.5m operational costs plus £39.3m on stations and equipment) ~ over £591,000 a day. The RNLI raised £196.9m in 2017 from legacies, donations, and trading activities such as their shops.

There has been a lifeboat station in Torbay since 1866. It currently has two lifeboats, the All Weather Severn (ALB) and Inshore Lifeboat D Class (ILB), covering a coastal area from Teignmouth to Start Bay. This station is one of the busiest in the country and expects over 100 launches in any one year. There are 5 large marinas within their operational area together with leisure and yacht clubs, all manner of water sports, as well as dangerous cliffs!

An ALB station costs over £215k a year to run, while an ILB costs £95k. Torbay has both, costing £310k pa. In 2018, Torbay Lifeboat Fundraisers raised close to £120k; the souvenir shops just under £48k; and the lifeboat station a further £96k; giving a total close to £264k that is a £46k shortfall.

## The Second Commandment

The Ten Commandments contain a summary of God's laws for human behaviour. The First Commandment stipulates that God alone is to be worshipped and the Second Commandment requires us to be very careful about how we worship him. God commands, ***"You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the waters under the earth. You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments."*** Exodus 20:4-6 ESV

Since God is infinitely great and transcendent so that he is above and different from his creation, it is a great evil to make any visual representation of him since it degrades his sovereign majesty and glory and transfers veneration and worship that justly belongs to God to a totally unworthy and corrupt object. Similarly, this Commandment forbids worshipping a god that is the product of our own imagination. This Commandment states that God is a jealous God meaning that he requires our total allegiance and commitment similar to that between a husband and wife. God takes careful note of our behaviour and threatens judgment on those whose actions express hatred towards him but promises blessing to those who love him.

We can rejoice that the Lord Jesus Christ who is both fully human and fully divine reveals to us the true image of the infinite God so that through coming to know Christ we come to know God. ***Philip said to him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us." Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father."*** John 14:8-9a ESV

Our last public meeting was with Brixham CP when Sarah Wollaston made her swansong appearance as a sitting MP. In an aside about neighbourhood plans she described the actions of government as nothing short of “betrayal”.

She was referring, of course, to the moving of the goalposts for the crucial area of “housing land supply”. This potentially consigns most local and neighbourhood plans to the bin and leaves the entire field open to developers.

Your Steering Committees are not taking this lying down, and are working very hard with neighbouring forums on trying to persuade the council and its officers to put up a fight to honour the wishes of the 90% of the voting ratepayers who said “yes” to neighbourhood plans across Torbay. This is not proving straightforward. Our local council is, at best, inscrutable about this.

The battle will be hard with the degree of money and influence lined up on the side of the developers against our impoverished council. December saw their online invitation to consult on their proposed budget for 2020/21 running to a mere 213 pages. The net message is that they are up the creek in terms of balancing the books without taking an axe to local services, having had their Town Council proposals rejected. We have invited someone senior to come to our 22 January meeting and give us an executive summary of all this. Your Steering Committee is not convinced by these arguments and will open a dialogue with the council on the whole issue of budgetary management. December also saw the publication for public consultation of the council’s draft Housing Strategy – a consultation closing before most people can begin to understand this jargon laden document. Something is very wrong with this “consultation” process which amounts to a box-ticking exercise of sticking complex proposals for the statutory minimum 6-week period on the council website. The council get a few hundred responses from a population of 130,000.

This issue features heavily in the Council Corporate Plan 2019/23, which is also on the council website for consultation! Senior members of council cabinet - and officers - have been invited to our January public meeting to explain these documents and discuss this “consultation” farrago. The November meeting also saw the attendance for the first time I can remember of residents under the age of 30! Two of them. They were enthused by the opportunity of discussing climate change action direct with local government, and I promised them I would try and build on their enthusiasm. Let’s try to get more young people along to meetings.
